### Adding to compost

Well drained soil is essential for growing alpine plants. Blend 4 part of garden soil or loam to 1 part Horticultural Sharp Sand for a perfect mix.

### Greenhouse benches

Use a bench that is at least 10cm (4") deep. Line with 2.5cm (1") of fine gravel. Layer this with 2.5cm (1") of Horticultural Sharp Sand. Lay soil-warming cables and cover with another 2.5cm (1") of sand. Cover with soil and plant.



### Other useful tips

1. In warm weather prevent alpines planted in clay pots drying out by sinking the pots into damp sharp sand up to their rim. Keep the sand damp. Water will pass through the sand to the pot.
2. Similarly, if your plants are accidentally over-watered, water will pass through the pot and drain away into the sand.
